HMCM (EXW/FMF/NAC/AW/SW) Peter Janse is a native of Natick, MA. He enlisted in the Navy in 1993 and after completing basic training, attended Hospital Corpsman "A" school followed by Aerospace Medicine School and Field Medical Service School. Following training, he served in El Toro, CA with the Marine Corps squadrons VMFA(AW)-121 "Green Knights" and HMM-164 "Knightriders" completing multiple deployments including the 13<sup>th</sup> MEU. There he qualified as an Arial Gunner and Naval Air Crewman.

In June of 1998, he was assigned to the Pentagon in Washington D.C., and was instrumental in creating the first completely integrated Tri-Service military medical facility. In June 2001, he reported to Surface Force Independent Duty Corpsman School in San Diego, CA, graduating with high honors in July 2002.

In August of 2002, he was selected for orders to the Minehunter USS CORMORANT (MHC-57) in Ingleside, TX. From 2005 through 2009 he served at the Joint POW/MIA Accounting Command in Oahu, Hawaii. There he promoted to Chief Petty Officer.

In 2009, HMC Janse deployed as an Individual Augmentee with the U.S. Army's 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne to the ISAF HQ Role I Medical Center in Kabul, Afghanistan. There he supported coalition forces with direct medical support, participating in multiple missions and operations with multinational forces. In June 2010, he reported to the Naval Hospital in Rota, Spain serving as the Directorate of Medical Services Senior Enlisted Advisor. While there, he earned his bachelor's degree in Health Sciences.

In July of 2013, he was assigned to Coastal Riverine Group ONE, Detachment Guam. There he promoted to Master Chief Petty Officer. Upon his promotion to Master Chief, he was assigned to the Naval Expeditionary Combat Command (NECC) in 2017 as the Force Medical Master Chief and Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Force Surgeon. There he oversaw the medical policy, logistics, and technology development for NECC's 20,000 personnel.

In June of 2020, he was selected for orders to the Senior Enlisted Academy in Newport, RI as a Faculty Advisor where he currently serves. He is a graduate of SEA Class 182 "GOLD" Team.

He is a qualified Expeditionary Warfare Specialist, Fleet Marine Force Warfare Specialist, Naval Air Crewman, Enlisted Air Warfare Specialist, and Enlisted Surface Warfare Specialist. His personal decorations include the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal, and various other campaign ribbons and medals.
