Master Chief Petty Officer, Barry Crawford, enlisted in the United States Navy Reserve on February 7, 1987.

Qualifying as an Aviation Electricians Mate (AE) he performed electronic systems maintenance on the Lockheed P3 Orion aircraft and between 1989 to 2005 completed four VP Patrol Squadron. Selected for Chief Petty Officer in 2005 he served as VP-92's 200 Division Leading Chief Petty Officer.

From 2005 to 2011 he completed several tours at U.S. Navy training commands developing enlisted and junior officers, including the Center for Naval Leadership (CNL), Center for Professional and Personnel Development (CPPD), U.S. Navy Senior Enlisted Academy (SEA), and Officer Training Command, Newport (NR OTCN). From 2014 to 2016 he served as the Course Director at the U.S. Navy Senior Enlisted Academy.

During his operational career, he completed patrol squadron theater missions to Japan, Italy, Ecuador, Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico. From Sep 2011 to Nov 2012 he was recalled to active duty and deployed with a 150 member Provincial Reconstruction Team (PRT) to Uruzgan Province, Afghanistan, employed as Staff S6-Communications Officer and Navy Senior Enlisted Leader. He advanced to Master Chief Petty Officer on this deployment.

From Jan 2013 to Feb 2017 AVCM Crawford served as Senior Enlisted Leader for NR Officer Training Command, Newport, RI. In April 2017, AVCM Crawford became the Commanding Officer of U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corp. Squadron 7-Zulu, Quincy, MA and in December 2018 became the Commanding Officer of POLA New England.

AVCM Crawford's qualifications include P3 Electrical Maintenance Technician, Aviation Warfare Specialist, Information Dominance Warfare Specialist, and Maser Training Specialist.

He is a graduate of the U.S. Navy Senior Enlisted Academy NRC-29 (Purple) and holds a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Eastern Nazarene College.

His military awards include the Meritorious Service Medal (2 awards), Navy Commendation Medal (2 awards), Navy Achievement Medal, Navy Reserve Meritorious Service Medal (8), Afghanistan Campaign Medal, as well as various unit and personal awards.

As a civilian he is the Vice President of Product Delivery at MassPrinting in Massachusetts. Originally from Los Angeles, CA, he resides in Wakefield, MA with his wife Joanne.
